

CM 110 Announcement

1. Information Technology Buildings at ELCOSEZ-Vilankurichi, Coimbatore and ELCOSEZ – Navalpattu, Tiruchy

In Vilankurichi Village, Coimbatore an ELCOSEZ has been created by ELCOT in 62 acres of land. The total investment made by ELCOT was ₹ 72.50 crore which includes the creation of infrastructure works and construction of 3524 sq. ft. administrative building.

In this ELCOSEZ 9.5 acres of land were allotted to M/s Tidel Park, Coimbatore Limited (TPCL) on lease basis. M/s TPCL has constructed 17 lakhs sq. ft. IT Building and the same is in operating with 11,000 employees. In this ELCOSEZ 9.5 acres of land were allotted to M/s Wipro Limited on lease basis. M/s Wipro Limited has constructed 3.5 lakhs sq. ft. IT Buildings and the same is in operating with 2000 employees.

In Navalpattu Village, Tiruchy an ELCOSEZ has been created by ELCOT in extent of 147.61 acres, out of which 123.23 acres of land has been accorded SEZ approval. The total investment made by ELCOT in this ELCOSEZ was ₹ 60.08 crore which includes the creation of infrastructure works and construction of 60,000 sq. ft. administrative cum IT Building. In this ELCOSEZ, ELCOT has made allotment of land to 8

companies. Till now none of the companies have started their first phase preliminary works.

Till date for further land allotment request of land, no companies have approached. Compared to large companies, MSME Companies have evinced interest to set up their companies in Tier-II cities such as Coimbatore and Tiruchy. Besides they wish to set up their companies in well-constructed building.

In view of the above, considering the prevailing market demand of IT/ITES entrepreneurs ELCOT has proposed to construct 2.50 lakh sq. ft. IT Building at an estimated cost of 100 crore at ELCOSEZ - Coimbatore Vilankurichi and 1 lakhs sq. ft. IT Building at an estimated cost of 40 crore at ELCOSEZ –Tiruchy, Navalpattu for starting their business operation by MSME companies.

2. Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN)

The Cyber Space is prone to be attacked accidentally or deliberately. Cyber attacks are being instigated against information technology infrastructure targeting the data of various welfare schemes of the Government. In recent times, the Information Technology Infrastructure is being subjected to multilevel and Cyber intrusion. The Cyber Space attackers / hackers are trying to take control of the Information Technology infrastructure as well as data. Hence, Cyber security is the essential part of each and every Department.

The Government of Tamil Nadu has implemented Tamil Nadu State Wide Area Network (TNSWAN) and Tamil Nadu State Data Centre (TNSDC) Schemes under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) through Electronic Corporation of Tamil Nadu Limited (ELCOT). It is essential to the State Government to provide the citizens a secured Internet Service as envisaged in the National Cyber Crisis Management Plan by protecting the Information Technology Infrastructures as well as Digital Services from unnecessary Cyber attacks and from obstacles.

It has been proposed Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN), the following actions are to be taken in this scheme :-

- Formation of Computer Emergency Response Team for Tamil

Nadu (CERT-IN),

- Setting of Tamil Nadu Security Operating Centre (TNSOC) for taking surveillance measures.
- Formulation of Cyber Crisis Management Plan for Tamil Nadu (CCMP-TN), which includes the preparation of action items for Computer Emergency Response Team for Tamil Nadu (CERT-TN), preparation of policies, process and guidelines of Tamil Nadu Security Operating Centre (TNSOC).
- Establishing Security Architecture framework for Tamil Nadu (SAF-TN) for selected Government Departments.

Hence, it is proposed to implement three year operations and maintenance (O&M) of the Cyber Security Infrastructure in Tamil Nadu at the estimated project cost of Rs.21.39 crore.

3. High Definition (HD) Digital Cable TV Service will be provided to the TACTV's Subscribers

At present, TACTV is providing Standard Definition (SD) Digital Cable TV Service to its Subscribers.
